### Past President's Outgoing Message



Serving as President of the Georgia Association of Fire Chiefs has been a great privilege. I would like to thank all of you that have supported me in this role and throughout my career. I am grateful for the support of the members of this great organization, the state agency heads, officers of our sister fire service organizations and associations, my department members, my Commissioner and County Administrator, and of course my family. I have had the opportunity to travel and meet with some of the best fire chiefs in

the nation to network and exchange ideas. I have had so many great experiences because of this opportunity afforded to me by this organization.

One of the greatest accomplishments we made during my term as President was the Firefighter Cancer Insurance Law. The fire service had been working for some time to get insurance coverage for Georgia's firefighters stricken with cancer. We were able to work with our Unification Partners, legislators, insurance companies, ACCG, and GMA to come up with a compromise and develop a program to cover our firefighters that is now being looked at by other states across the nation.

When I became President one of the greatest problems facing our state was the very high number of fire fatalities in the state. I learned that the Southeast is the leading region in the nation for fire fatalities and in 2016, Georgia led the Southeast in fire fatalities. We immediately began to work with other organizations to form the Georgia Fire Prevention Task Force to look into ways to prevent fire fatalities and injuries. Although we as a state assoc. had adopted "Turn Your Attention to Fire Prevention" we had done little to promote and support it. The task force worked to look for ways not only to educate the public, but to help fire departments put an infuses on fire prevention efforts. Thanks to much work from our partner organizations we have been able to combine efforts and provide training and resources to lower fire fatalities in our state.

Another area that needed improvement and more attention to cooperation in our state was mutual aid. GMAG already had the groundwork in place, but it is up to all of us as fire chiefs to make it work and share our resources in our greatest time of need. We were able to form the Ga. Mutual Aid Task Force to look into ways to improve relationships and collect resource data. The GAFC utilized our contract with the IAFC to use the MutualAidNet system to collect the data from as many Ga. fire departments as possible and we are now working with the IAFC to be a pilot state to utilize the newer version of NMAS.

These are all things that we accomplished together as a fire service. A unified fire service is a strong fire service. Together we will keep working to improve our service and protect our citizens.
