Applicants must submit a transcript showing proof of completion*** (Related or Non-Related Field)

Recertification credit from the National Fire Academy On-Campus Programs

- Managing Officer Program applies to recertification hours for GCFOC and GVCFOC only. Recertification credit will be received for the completion of a year curriculum.
- Executive Fire Officer (EFO) Program applies to all 4 levels of recertification. Recertification credit will be received for the completion of a year curriculum.

Transcripts or Certificates are required in order to receive credit.
